## Notice of Race

### 1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules defined as ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (2013-2016).

### 2. Advertising

**2.1** Advertising will be restricted to Category C.

**2.2** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

### 3. Eligibility and Entry

**3.1** The regatta is open to all dinghy classes.

**3.2** In order for a boats' entry to be accepted and valid, a fully completed and signed Entry Form (including the Consent for Junior Sailors where applicable) must be submitted at registration along with payment of the appropriate entry fee.

**3.3** An entry fee of \$20 is payable for Sabots, Optis and Open Bic Junior Classes, with all other class entry fees' being \$25. The entry fee is payable at registration and will include entry to all races, eligibility for prizes, as well as afternoon tea after Sunday's presentation.

**3.4** All boats entered in a boat class must comply with their specific class rules.

### 5. Venue

Racing will be conducted on the waters of southern Lake Macquarie in the vicinity of the host club.

### 6. Courses

The courses to be sailed will be displayed at the competitors briefing.

### 7. Scoring

**7.1** The Low Point Scoring system will apply.

**7.2** One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

## **8. Classes**

**8.1** Individual classes will be recognised if 5 or more boats register or at the discretion of the organizing authority.

## **9. Prizes**

**9.1** Prizes will be awarded to first and second in each class.

**9.2** Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority.

## **10. Camping**

Strictly limited tent sites will be permitted in the designated area adjacent to the clubhouse. A council imposed camping fee of \$28 per tent per night is payable to SLMASC at registration. A camping permit will be issued by the Club and must be retained for presentation to LMCC Rangers who may inspect the camping area during the event. Toilet and shower facilities are available 24hrs at the Club.
