Notice of Race

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules defined as ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-2020).

2. Advertising

Advertising will be restricted to Category C.

3. Eligibility and entry

- 3.1. This regatta is open for all Single handed Monohull classes. The following classes are also invited to enter: Nacra 15s and 17s; Flying Ants; and all Windsurfer Classes.
A minimum of 5 Boats / Boards are required per class to be eligible for class prizes.
- 3.2. All entered boats must comply with their specific class rules.
- 3.3. A discounted early entry fee of \$40 (\$30 if all competitors on the boat are under 18 years of age) is payable by 29th October 2017 either by direct deposit (please email entry form to treasurer@slmasc.org) or cheque sent with attached entry form to:

- 3.4. Entries after 29th October will be accepted up until the end of registration on Saturday 4th November with the full entry fee of \$60 being payable.

5. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

6. Venue

Racing will be conducted on the waters of southern Lake Macquarie in the vicinity of the host club.

7. Racing

Classes with more than 10 entries will have their own start.
Classes entitled to race but having less than 10 entries may have single class or combined class starts at the discretion of the Race Committee.
A maximum of 8 races are scheduled for each class.
On Sunday the 5th November there will be no Warning signal after 1530hrs

8. Courses

The course to be sailed will be outlined in the Sailing Instructions. The intent is for windward / leeward type courses or trapezoids with a target winning time of 30mins.

9. Scoring

- 9.1. The Low Point Scoring system will apply.
- 9.2. The scoring system is as follows:
- 9.3. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
 - a) When three races or less have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - b) When four or more races have been completed a boat's series score will exclude her worst score.

10. Prizes

Class and other prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority.

11. Camping

A strictly limited number of tent camp sites will be permitted in the designated area adjacent to the clubhouse. A council imposed camping fee of \$30 per tent site per night is payable to SLMASC at registration. A camping permit will be issued by the club and must be retained for presentation to LMCC Rangers who may call to check these. Toilet and shower facilities will be available 24hrs at the club.

If you plan to camp at the club, it is strongly recommended that you telephone Diana Charlton on 02 4973 6162 to request a camp site in advance and then confirm your booking with your completed regatta entry by 29th October. Due to council restrictions the numbers of camp sites available are strictly limited, so sites will not be held after 27th October without a completed entry.

12. Some meals will be available at the club across the weekend. Further details will be available on the club website (Zhik Single Handed Regatta page) prior to the event and at welcome/briefing. Take away food and groceries can also be purchased at the Bay Shopping Village (5 min drive from club).
