Notice of Race

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules defined as ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (2013-2016).

2. Advertising

Advertising will be restricted to Category C.

Eligibility and entry 3.

- **3.1** This regatta is open for all single handed monohull classes plus an invitation for "A Class" Catamarans to also enter.
- **3.2** All entered boats must comply with their specific class rules.
- **3.3** Early entry fee of \$40 is payable by 1st November 2015 either by direct deposit or cheque sent with attached entry form to: South Lake Macquarie Amateur Sailing Club PO Box 53, Morisset NSW 2264

3.4 Beach entries will be accepted at registration with a late entry fee of \$50.

5. **Sailing Instructions**

The Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

6. Venue

Racing will be conducted on the waters of southern Lake Macquarie in the vicinity of the host club.

7. Courses

The course to be sailed will be integrative to "Attachment A" with a target winning time of 45 min elapsed.

8. Scoring

- **8.1** The Low Point Scoring system will apply.
- **8.2** The scoring system is as follows:
 - One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. a)
 - b) When three races or less have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - c) When four or more races have been completed a boat's series score will exclude her worst score.

9. Corrected Times

Individual class ratings will be nominated at the discretion of the organizing authority and will be displayed on the notice board prior to race one. Ratings may or may not conform to the VYC class yardsticks and will not be altered during the regatta unless formal appeal for special consideration or dispute of rating is submitted and the request is granted by the PRO.

10. Prizes

- **10.1** Scratch prizes will be awarded based on yardstick results overall.
- **10.2** Handicap prizes will be awarded overall using TCF handicaps calculated from using results from the first day.
- **10.3** Class and other prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority.

11. Camping

A strictly limited number of tent camp sites will be permitted in the designated area adjacent to the clubhouse. A council imposed camping fee of \$26 per tent site per night is payable to SLMASC at registration. A camping permit will be issued by the club and must be retained for presentation to LMCC Rangers who may call to check these. Toilet and shower facilities are available 24hrs at the club.



Due to council restrictions the numbers of camp sites available are strictly limited, so sites will not be held after 1st November without a completed entry.
