Notice of Race

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules defined as ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-2020), the prescriptions and YA Special regulations, Part 2, Off The Beach as well as any amendments in the SLMASC Sailing Instructions or advised at briefing.

2. Advertising

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category C.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all dinghy classes.
- 3.2 In order for a boats' entry to be accepted and valid, a fully completed and signed Entry Form and Entry Declaration (including the Consent for Junior Sailors where applicable) must be submitted at registration along with payment of the appropriate entry fee.
- 3.3 Entry fee payable at registration: Single Hander Classes - Junior \$15 / Senior \$25, Multi hander Classes - Junior \$25 / Senior \$35. Entry fee includes entry to all races, eligibility for prizes, Sausage Sizzle Saturday after racing and afternoon tea after Sunday's presentation.
- 3.4 All boats entered in a boat class must comply with their specific class rules.

4. Schedule of events

- 4.1 Entrants will be advised of their Course allocation and Starting Division at the competitors briefing.
- 4.2 A maximum of two races are scheduled for the regatta

4.3 One race is required to constitute a series.

5. Venue

Racing will be conducted on the waters of southern Lake Macquarie in the vicinity of the host club.

6. Courses

The courses to be sailed will be displayed / described at the competitors briefing.

7. Scoring

7.1 The Low Point Scoring system will apply.

7.2 All races will be included in a boats series score.

8. Classes

8.1 Individual classes will be recognised if 5 or more boats register or at the discretion of the organizing authority.

9. Insurance

Each competing boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUD \$1,000,000 (recommended \$5,000,000), per incident or the equivalent. Entrants will be required at registration to sign a declaration that they hold this insurance cover.

10. Prizes

10.1 Prizes will be awarded to first and second in each class.

10.2 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority.

11. Catering

The Club Canteen and Licensed Bar will operate both days of the Regatta. A **Sausage Sizzle (Saturday after racing)** and **Afternoon-Tea (Sunday after presentation)** will be provided **free for all competing sailors.**

The Bay Hotel is located within the Bay Shopping Village within a few minutes of the club and has full Bar, Restaurant and Bottle Shop services available across the weekend. Numerous take away food outlets and a Coles supermarket are also located within the Bay Shopping Village.

12. Camping

Strictly limited tent sites will be permitted in the designated area adjacent to the clubhouse. A council imposed camping fee of \$35 per tent per night is payable to SLMASC at registration. A camping permit will be issued by the Club and must be retained for presentation to LMCC Rangers who may inspect the camping area during the event. Toilet and shower facilities are available 24hrs at the Club.
